

GOVERNMENT FUNDING

Uses of local government revenue have certain restrictions pursuant to state statute.

TOWN OF SELLERSBURG CIVIL GOVERNMENT:


The Sellersburg Town Civil Government is funded through property taxes and other funding sources from the state such as gas tax, cigarette tax, and vehicle registration fees. Some of these taxes from the state have specific uses and cannot be used for things outside of its definition within state statute. These dollars are then allocated by the Town Council for the budgets of these departments:
